Membership of SSCC is subject to terms and conditions.

MEMBERSHIP

MEMBERSHIP IS FROM 1 July to 30 June each year

Membership is activated when we receive from you a completed application form and payment **and acceptance by the Chamber's executive committee**. A receipt will be issued upon receipt of payment for the period to 30th June of the current Financial year.

Membership is for the financial year or part thereof in which your application is accepted, and is renewable on the 1st July for a subsequent year.

Unless accessing monthly direct debit facilities, all membership fees must be paid annually in advance.

An invoice for annual membership fees and which is payable prior to your renewal date will be sent to you before the membership renewal date.

Membership may be suspended or terminated if your payment is not received within thirty (30) days of the membership renewal date. In this circumstance, SSCC reserves the right to recover the monetary benefit of any membership discount(s) received by the subscriber whilst the subscriber was in arrears.

REFUNDS: There is no refund of any membership fees should you cancel your membership at any stage during your membership year.

Changes to membership fees will only be made at the time of annual renewal of your membership.

Membership is not transferable unless your business changes name throughout the course of your membership.

You must notify us of changes to your contact details in writing (by letter, fax or email) otherwise we may not be able to make our services available to you.

We reserve the right to change, from time to time, the services available to members.
